

## "Madison Capitol East District"

The Dane County BUILD Advisory Committee identified a number of goals for the Madison Capitol East District: providing a balance of residential space, employment development, and office space, parking ease and accessibility and overall site design. Gentile's Master Plan emphasizes an improved streetscape and alternative transportation for this heavily traveled area. In Central Park, Gentile proposes a submerged stage, rooftop seating at an outdoor restaurant, a reflection pool, and living walls. A promenade, green house and skate park complete this community gathering place. In addition, the regional inter-city rail station—Yahara Station—will feature sustainable technologies, green roofs, and a new, lake-inspired design.






- (A) Central Park (B) Grand Stage

- (J) Capitol East District Model




